TOWN Day

We had wonderful weather for Town Day, September 20, 2025, and lots of people stopped by our booth to learn about what we've been doing in the Garden. Many folks signed up to volunteer with planting and maintenance. It was great to be able to direct people to look at the Garden right behind our booth's location, and to suggest that they walk through when they had a chance to take in its serenity and beauty.

PLANTINGS IN THE GARDEN

This spring, summer and fall we have been working on a third Community Preservation Act (CPA) grant to continue plant restoration, irrigation, and additional plants where they can be needed. This phase of the garden restoration is still in progress, with final planting scheduled for the spring of 2026. We are replacing many of the missing original shrubs on either side of the reflecting pool, and the new shrubs and trees on the hill behind the Menotomy Indian Hunter, removing invasive shrubs, and replanting portions of the beds that border the grassy oval and the brick pathway.



We hope you can visit the gardens and bring your friends to experience the beautiful gardens in the center of Arlington. The Friends always welcome visitors to join us at member meetings or cleanups.
